## Let's Start With the Basics:

1. Not all paint is created equally. If you want a high quality paint job, you need to invest in the right products. This doesn't have to mean the most expensive, but the right product for the job. And buy it from a supplier that specializes in paint. Would you pay a lawyer to work on your teeth?
2. The quality of the gear you buy matters! Especially your brush. Next up is your roller sleeve. Not all applicators are created for all products.



### CLEANUP MATTERS!

A well taken care of piece of equipment will stand the test of time. Make sure to check our video on "[How to Clean Your Paint Brush](#)" – for latex paints.

You can wrap brushes/rollers tightly in plastic wrap overnight for use the next day.

## MUST HAVES

- BRUSH (2.5" ANGLED RECOMMENDED)
- PAINT/PRIMER (DUH)
- ROLLER CAGE
- ROLLER SLEEVE (SIZE DEPEND ON SURFACE)
- PAINT TRAY
- SAND PAPER (GRIT DEPNDNS ON SURFACE)
- DROP CLOTH
- 5-IN-1 (CAN OPENER)
- RAGS

## JOB DEPENDENT

- STEP STOOL
- POLE
- SCREWDRIVER(S)
- PUTTY KNIFE/VES
- FILLER (DRYWALL, WOOD, ETC)
- CAULK-CAULKING GUN
- TAPE (ONLY IF YOU REALLY NEED TO!) ;)
